2.	assembly	a group of people, especially one that meets regularly for a particular purpose, such as government (συνέλευση)
3.	atrocities	an act of great cruelty and wickedness (φρικαλεότητα)
4.	bill	a formal statement of a planned new law that is discussed before being voted on (νομοσχέδιο)
5.	colossal	huge; enormous (κολλοσιαίος)
6.	complement	(v.) to complete, make perfect (συμπληρώνω)
7.	consensus	unanimity or general agreement (συναίνεση, ομοφωνία)
8.	dissent	disagree (διαφωνώ, αντιτίθεται)
9.	draft	first rough form (προσχέδιο)
10.	driving force	impetus, the main force (κινητήρια δύναμη)
11.	expound	to explain in detail; to clarify (εξηγώ, ερμηνεύω)
12.	inalienable	sacred; incapable of being transferred, lost, or taken away (αναφαίρετος)
13.	latitude	the distance north or south of the equator (γεωγραφικό πλάτος)
14.	memoirs	a kind of writing that tells someone's memories (απομνημονεύματα)
15.	oppression	the state of being kept down by unjust use of force or authority (καταπίεση)
16.	perceive	to understand, know, become aware of (αντιλαμβάνομαι)
17.	pluralist	characterized by the presence of many different ethnic, religious, or cultural groups.
18.	preliminary	introductory (προκαταρκτικός)
19.	prompt	quick (ταχύς, άμεσος)
20.	resolution	decision, conclusion (λύση, απόφαση)
21.	retort	a quick reply to a question or remark (especially a witty or critical one) (ανταπάντηση)
22.	session	period of time during which, each year, Congress assembles and conducts business (σύνοδος, συνεδρία)
23.	solidarity	a genuine concern for the well-being of other people, unity (αλληλεγγύη)
