9. displace (v)	to force something or someone out of its usual or original position (εκτοπίζω, μετατοπίζω)		
10. encounter	to meet unexpectedly (συναντώ, αντιμετωπίζω)		
11. fend for	take care of yourself (συντηρούμαι μόνος μου)		
12. genocide	eliberate elimination of a group through mass murder (γενοκτονία)		
13. impart (v)	to give away, share (μεταδίδω)		
14. irreversible	permanent, irrevocable (ανεπανόρθωτος)		
15. mutilation	to damage something severely, especially by violently removing a part (ακρωτηριασμός)		
16. orientation	act of finding oneself in society (προσανατολισμός)		
17. premeditated	considered beforehand, deliberately planned (προμελετημένος)		
18. recruit	to persuade someone to work for a company or become a new member of an organization, especially the army (στρατολογώ)
