1. assume	to take on; adopt (αναλαμβάνω)
2. boundaries	limitations, borders (όρια)
3. complement	to complete, perfect (συμπληρώνω)
4. consent	permission, agreement (συγκατάθεση, συναίνεση)
5. convention	a large formal meeting of people who do a particular job or have a similar interest, or a large meeting for a political party (συνέδριο, συνέλευση)
6. cornerstone	a fundamental principle or element (ακρογωνιαίος λίθος)
7. curtail	to cut short or reduce (περικόπτω)
8. customary	commonly used or practiced (νόμιμος, συνηθισμένος)
9. deprivation	withholding, removal, loss (στέρηση)
10. dignity	the quality of being worthy of esteem or respect $(\alpha\xi\iota\circ\pi\rho\acute{\epsilon}\pi\epsilon\iota\alpha)$
11. discrimination	behaving differently, usually unfairly, toward the members of a group. ($\delta\iota\dot{\alpha}\kappa\rho\iota\sigma\eta$)
12. elimination	the process of removing something ($\epsilon \xi \acute{a} \lambda \epsilon \iota \psi \eta$)
13. entitled to	given the right to (δικαιούται να)
14. exhaustive	complete and thorough (εξαντλητικός)
15. facilitate	make easier, help the progress of (διευκολύνω)
16. inalienable	sacred; incapable of being transferred, lost, or taken away (αναφαίρετος)
17. indivisible	not separable into parts (αδιαίρετος)
18. inherent	(adj) existing as a permanent, essential quality; intrinsic ($\acute{\epsilon}\mu\phi\upsilon\tau\sigma\varsigma$)
19. interrelated	connected in such a way that each thing has an effect on the others (αλληλένδετος)
20. ratify	approve formally; confirm; verify (επικυρώνω)
21. refrain	to hold back, stop oneself from doing something (απέχω, αποφεύγω)
22. reiterate	to say again, repeat (επαναλαμβάνω)
23. treaty	a written agreement between two or more countries, formally approved and signed by their leader (συνθήκη, συμφωνία)
