

Countable nouns (C):

- nouns we can count
- singular and plural

→ a book, two books

Uncountable nouns (UC):

- nouns we can't count
- ONLY singular
- we can't use a/an
- *if* we want to use them in plural, we need specific phrases: a slice of..., a cup of..., a glass of..., a bar of..., a grain of..., a packet of..., a loaf of...

→ rice, bread, cheese
