όταν το ρήμα τελειώνει σε **σύμφωνο + y**, **βγάζουμε το y** και βάζουμε **-ies**

*We are staying at my friend's house for the weekend.*

### 4) Περιγράφω μια φωτογραφία/ descriptions

*The boy is having lunch.*

### Time expressions:

now, at the moment: τώρα

today: σήμερα

tonight: σήμερα το βράδυ

this year: αυτό τον χρόνο

these days: αυτές τις μέρες

### Spelling rules:

όταν το ρήμα τελειώνει σε **-e**, βγάζουμε το **-e** για να βάλουμε **-ing**  
write- writing

όταν το ρήμα τελειώνει σε **σύμφωνο + φωνήεν + σύμφωνο**,  
διπλασιάζουμε το τελευταίο σύμφωνο για να βάλουμε **-ing**  
stop —> **stopping**
