

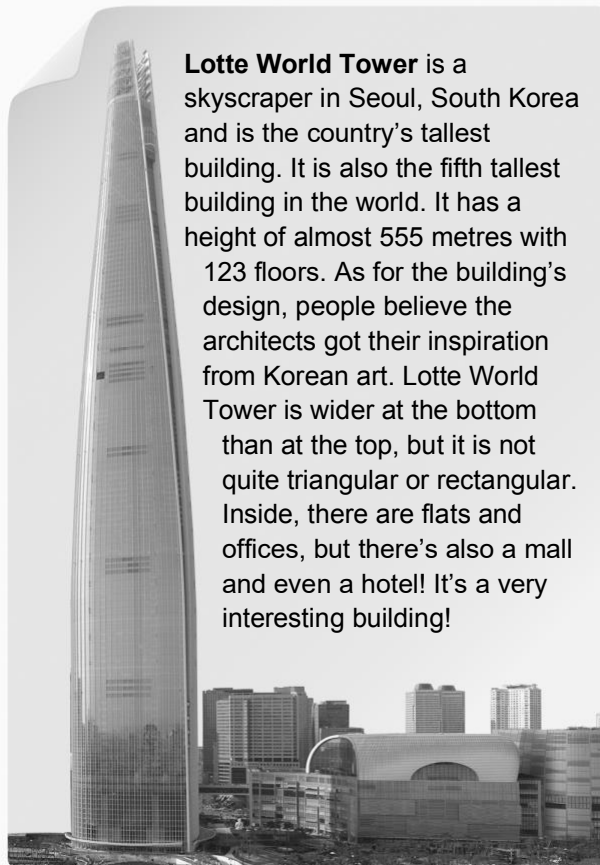

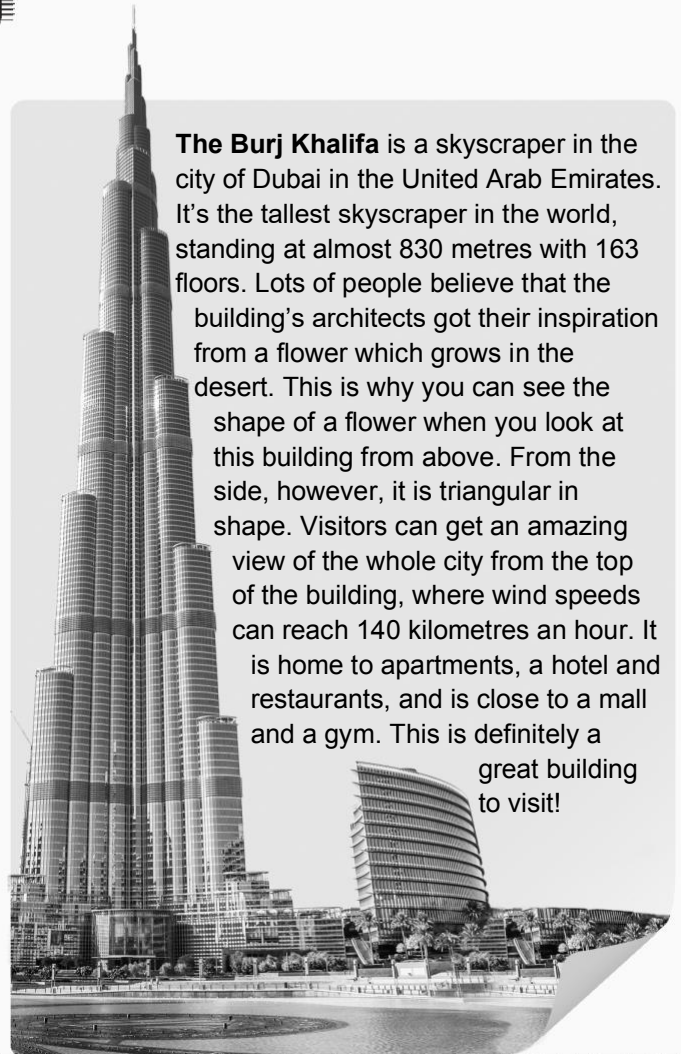

Lotte World Tower is a skyscraper in Seoul, South Korea and is the country's tallest building. It is also the fifth tallest building in the world. It has a height of almost 555 metres with 123 floors. As for the building's design, people believe the architects got their inspiration from Korean art. Lotte World Tower is wider at the bottom than at the top, but it is not quite triangular or rectangular. Inside, there are flats and offices, but there's also a mall and even a hotel! It's a very interesting building!



The Burj Khalifa is a skyscraper in the city of Dubai in the United Arab Emirates. It's the tallest skyscraper in the world, standing at almost 830 metres with 163 floors. Lots of people believe that the building's architects got their inspiration from a flower which grows in the desert. This is why you can see the shape of a flower when you look at this building from above. From the side, however, it is triangular in shape. Visitors can get an amazing view of the whole city from the top of the building, where wind speeds can reach 140 kilometres an hour. It is home to apartments, a hotel and restaurants, and is close to a mall and a gym. This is definitely a great building to visit!
