

too / enough / so / such

too... to...

e.g.: This is too good to be true!

- **too + adjective / adverb + full infinitive (to do)**

e.g.: I'm too tall to play football.

- **too + adjective / adverb + for someone / something + full infinitive (to do)**

e.g.: It's too difficult for students to be quiet.



... enough ...

e.g.: I am tall enough to play basketball!

- **adjective / adverb + enough + full infinitive (to do)**

e.g.: She's **strong enough** to win the game.


- **enough + noun**

e.g.: I've got **enough money** to buy the newest iPhone.



Oh my!
This car is
too expensive!

I'd like to buy a
very expensive
car. No cheap
stuff!





This is little **Ivy!**



... such ...

- **such + (a/an) + adjective + countable noun**

e.g.: Little Ivy is **such an adorable** girl!

- **such + (a/an) + adjective + countable noun + that + sentence**

e.g.: Little Ivy is **such an adorable** girl **that** everyone wants to be her friend.

- **such + adjective + uncountable noun + that + sentence**

e.g.: Little Ivy has **such incredible** character **that** her teachers admire a lot.

I don't want to say hello to you because I'm going to lose this match! Leave me alone!

This is little **Stan!**





... **SO** ...

- **so + adjective**

e.g.: Stan is **so focused** on playing video games!

- **so + adjective + that + sentence**

e.g.: Stan is **so absorbed that** he sometimes forgets to be polite.



There was **so much** traffic.

There was **such a lot of** traffic.
