<b>hemp (n)</b>	a tall plant first found in Asia which is an important source of fibre for rope and coarse cloth, <i>ινδική κάνναβη</i>	A number of products, including paper and clothing - even food and beer - are made from hemp.			
<b>leather (n)</b>	animal skin that has been treated to preserve it, and is used for making shoes, bags etc, <i>δέρμα</i>	The inside of the bag was lined with soft leather.			
<b>nettle (n)</b>	a wild plant whose leaves sting you if you touch them, <i>τσουκνίδα</i>	Nettle has many medicinal uses.
