



Passive Voice

- ✚ **Use:** χρησιμοποιείται όταν δεν μας ενδιαφέρει ποιος κάνει την ενέργεια αλλά σε ποιον ή τι γίνεται. Δηλαδή, δίνουμε έμφαση στο αντικείμενο της πράξης, όχι στο υποκείμενο.

✚ **Simple Present**

- **Form:** am / is / are + past participle
- **Examples:**

Active	Passive
They clean the classroom every day.	The classroom is cleaned every day.
She writes a letter.	A letter is written .

✚ **Simple Past**

- **Form:** was/ were + past participle
- **Examples:**

Active	Passive
They built this house in 1990.	This house was built in 1990.
The teacher explained the rules.	• The rules were explained .
