- 1. Write a **book review** for the school blog.
- If you were a character in the story, what would you be called?
 Remember, your character name needs to start with 'The'. Draw yourself
 in a frame using a heavy ink pen or a marker and make a new page.
- 3. **Pick a quote that resonates with you.** Make your own drawing of it and explain why you were drawn in these words in particular.
- 4. What does "home" mean to the boy, and what does it mean to you? Make a drawing and write a quote about it.
- 5. Make a new page in the book drawing your own illustrations and adding your own ideas.
- 6. Book Trailer: Create a video of 1-2 minutes advertising the book *The Boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse* in a way that will make other students your age interested in reading it. You can use live-action, animation, or any method of combining words and images that you wish, as long as the result is an effective and accurate advertisement and properly credits image sources.

- 7. **Podcast:** Working with a group of no more than three people, write and record a podcast of 5-10 minutes on the book *The Boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse*. You can incorporate music, interviews, or any other common content matter to podcasts.
- 8. Choose some songs **to make a playlist** that reflect the themes of the book, such as friendship, kindness, or self-discovery. Instrumental tracks or songs with simple, meaningful lyrics work best.
