C' CLASS PROJECT WORK

- **When presenting orally remember:** a) your experience while presenting or watching other presentations in class, b) that you can watch the video for useful tips, and c) that this time we will use four criteria (delivery/content/structure/visuals) to assess the presentations (check the rubric).
- For your team to be successful, **assign roles and divide tasks** after you make your choice all together.

The Project Advocate: This is a traditional *project manager* type of role. As such, they take on the responsibility for having the general overview of the project, the general planning and ensuring that everything is on schedule.

The Specialist: The most common role is that of a specialist. This is a team member who is particularly good at something. They have a specialised skillset which allows them to take responsibility for an area of the project.

The Researcher(s): The researcher will have the responsibility to come up with ways to gather the information the team needs and ensure that team can act upon this information.

The Report Writer(s): The person responsible for typing and editing the plan so as to be presented in the class.

The Project Presenter(s): The person who will present the plan to the class.

- When you choose a festival, you need to find out and report in class as part of your presentation **if the specific festival/tradition is inscribed in the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO.**
