SIMPLE PRESENT

I play football every Saturday.

I go to school every afternoon.

On Sundays I stay at home.

I am here.

SIMPLE PAST

I went to bed early yesterday.

I got up at 8.00 a.m.

I AM GOING TO... do something in the future-→

**I am going to work** with my uncle on the farm. (FUTURE INTENTIONS)

**I am going to play** a game with my cousin tomorrow.

**I am going to visit** a friend on Sunday.

**I am going to work** on a project next week.

I like tea. But right now, I would like to drink a coke. (τώρα)

I like drinking tea. (γενικά)

I want to go to the movies/ I want to visit Rome one day.

I want to go shopping tomorrow.

## Conditionals

If + Present --→ will + bare infinitive (1<sup>st</sup>) (possible)

E. g. If I have time tomorrow, I will send you a letter. (80%)

If + Past ---→ would + bare infinitive (2<sup>nd</sup>) (impossible)

E.g. If I won the lotto tomorrow, I would take all of you to the Bahamas. (20%)
