January 13,14 1944.

Anne continues to explore her self and her emotions she writes about her wish to not be seen as only a child. She also says about her continuing tension between her and her mother and she feels that her father often sides with her mother. Anne is also fascinated on the idea of becoming a writer

January 15 1944.

Anne writes about her fears for the future, the war and the impact it has on her family and those in hiding. Anne says her concerns about the possibility of never being able to live a normal life again.

January 16,17 1944.

Anne writes about her feelings towards Peter the boy she has been spending time with and how their relationship is developing though is still complicated.

January 18,19 1944.

Anne continues to explore her thoughts relationships and her desire for personal freedom she mentions the limitations of life in hiding and the way it has affected her emotional well being.

January 20,21 1944.

Anne writes about her constant anxiety about being discover and the growing tensions between the residents but she remains hopeful about the future

January 22,24 1944.

Anne writes about her changes during the period of hiding. She talks about her body, changing the emotions she is experiencing and her desire to be understood.

January 25,28 1944.

Anne writing about her sense of being torn between her desire for freedom and the need to stay hidden for safety. Her relationship with peter has evolve and she feels affection for him. Anne also writes about her thoughts for her future thoughts and she becomes aware of the unstable situation in the annex
