Hydra is a small island in the Argosaronic Gulf. Although Hydra is a name that means a place with plenty of water, Hydra is dry and rocky. Since farming was impossible, the island could not offer much to make a living. As a result, the people who first came to live on the island started building ships. For the same reason, when the Turks took over Hydra in 1715, they paid no attention to its dry land. The clever Hydriots then built up an important number of ships, which finally made up two-thirds of the whole Greek Sea Force. The Hydriots joined the Greek War of Independence against the Turks in 1821. Two of the most important men who fought in the Greek Revolution came from Hydra. The first one was Andreas Miaoulis, who gave commands to all the Greek ships. The second one was Georgios Koundouriotis, who was the first Prime Minister of the newly born Greek State from 1822 to 1827.



If you go to Hydra, you must visit the Museum of Hydra. Hydrian costumes, objects from the War of Independence and paintings of the ships of the 1821 Greek Revolution are on display there. More importantly, Miaoulis' heart, the heart of Greece, is "alive" in the Hall of Paintings of the Museum of Hydra even today.
