shabby	<i>adjective</i>	untidy and in bad condition (φθαρμένος, κουρελιασμένος)
troublesome	<i>adjective</i>	causing a lot of problems for someone (προβληματικός)
tiresome	<i>adjective</i>	annoying and making you lose patience (βαρετός, κουραστικός)
tasteless	<i>adjective</i>	likely to upset someone (άγευστος, άνοστος, κακόγουστος, άκομψος)
spotless	<i>adjective</i>	extremely clean (άψογος, πεντακάθαρος)
quaint	<i>adjective</i>	attractive because of being unusual and especially old-fashioned (γραφικός)
off-putting	<i>adjective</i>	slightly unpleasant or worrying so that you do not want to get involved in any way (ενοχλητικός, απωθητικός)
moderate	<i>adjective</i>	neither small nor large in size, amount, degree, or strength (μέτριος, μετριοπαθής)
minute =tiny	<i>adjective</i>	extremely small (μικροσκοπικός, μικρός, ασήμαντος)
mediocre	<i>adjective</i>	not very good , average (μέτριος)
marginal	<i>adjective</i>	very small in amount or effect (οριακός, περιθωριακός)
intriguing	<i>adjective</i>	very interesting because of being unusual or mysterious (μυστηριώδης, που κεντρίζει το ενδιαφέρον)
tranquil	<i>adjective</i>	calm and peaceful and without noise, violence, worry, etc. (γαλήνιος, ήρεμος)
tedious	<i>adjective</i>	boring (ανιαρός, μονότονος)
state-of-the-art	<i>adjective</i>	very modern and using the most recent ideas and methods (υπερσύγχρονος, eg. state-of-the-art technology)
scarce	<i>adjective</i>	not easy to find or get (σπάνιος, λιγοστός)
inferior (to sth/sb) #superior	<i>adjective</i>	not good, or not as good as someone or something else (κατώτερος)
immense	<i>adjective</i>	extremely large in size or degree huge, vast (τεράστιος, αχανής)
harsh	<i>adjective</i>	unpleasant, unkind, cruel, or more severe than is necessary (δριμύς, σκληρός, eg. harsh weather conditions, harsh criticism)
abnormal	<i>adjective</i>	different from what is usual or average, especially in a way that is bad (αφύσικος)
