household (n): all the people living together in a house / νοικοκυριά

illustrate (v): to demonstrate / αναδεικνύω

impetuous (adj): impulsive, rash / παρορμητικός

inferiority (n): state of not being as good as sb else / κατωτερότητα

line (n): connected series of people following one another in time / σειρά

manor (n): large country house with lands / αρχοντικό, έπαυλη

monopolise (v): to take the greatest share of / μονοπολιώ
