Consumer (pn)	a person who buys goods or services for their own use
Industrial (adj)	in or related to industry, or having a lot of industry and factories, etc
Efficiency (n)	the good use of time and energy in a way that does not waste any
Trump (v)	to beat someone or something
Welfare (n)	physical and mental health and happiness, especially of a person
Profit (n)	money that is earned in trade or business after paying the costs of producing and selling goods and services
At the expense of	resulting in the loss of something
Slaughter (v)	the killing of animals for meat
Exclude (v)	to intentionally not include something
Federal (adj)	relating to the central government, and not to the government of a region, of some countries such as the US
Urgently (adv)	in a way that needs attention very soon, especially before anything else, because of being very important
Raise public awareness	Help people acquire knowledge that something exists, or understanding of a situation or subject at the present time based on information or experience
Plight (n)	an unpleasant condition, especially a serious, sad, or difficult one
Adoption (n)	accepting or starting to use something new
Volume (n)	the number or amount of something in general
Manipulation (n)	controlling someone or something to your own advantage, often unfairly or dishonestly
