Passionate (adj)	having very strong feelings or emotions
Advocate (n)	someone who publicly supports something
Refugee camp	a place where people who have escaped their own country can live, usually in bad conditions and only expecting to stay for a limited time

To flee-fled-fled (v)	to escape by running away, especially because of danger or fear
Bright (adj)	clever

Sibling (adj)	Brother or sister
Border (n)	the line that divides one country from another

Conviction (n)	a strong opinion or belief

To dispel (v)	to remove fears, doubts, and false ideas, usually by proving them wrong or unnecessary
