2	refugee	a person who has escaped from their own country for political, religious, or economic reasons or because of war	πρόσφυγας

4	immigrate immigrant immigration	to come to live in a different country a person who has come into a foreign country in order to live there permanently the process by which people come in to a foreign country to live there, or the number of people coming in	μεταναστεύω μετανάστης μετανάστευση
