1	blackbird	a bird with black feathers and a yellow beak	κοτσούφι →
2	hatch	to come out of an egg	εκκολάπτομαι
3	solitary	alone, done alone	μοναχικός
4	melodious	very pleasant to listen to	μελωδικός
5	perch	(of a bird) to rest on a branch or other object	κουρνιάζω
6	plunge	to (cause sb or sth to) move or fall suddenly and often a long way forward, down, or into sth	βουτάω
7	in formation	done in a pattern by a number of people, vehicles, etc. moving together	σε σχηματισμό
8	civil rights movement	campaign for human freedoms	κίνημα για πολιτικά δικαιώματα
9	passionately	ardently, enthusiastically	με πάθος, ένθερμα
10	faith	the feeling of being certain that something exists or is true	πίστη
11	veil	to cover something, especially the face or body, with a veil	καλύπτω, κρύβω + πέπλο
12	in the dead of night	in the middle of the night	τα μεσάνυχτα
13	arise - arose - arisen	to start to happen or exist	προκύπτω + σηκώνομαι
14	sink - sank/sunk - sunk/sunken	to (cause something or someone to) fall or move to a lower level or below the surface of a liquid	βυθίζομαι, βουλιάω
15	wing →	the flat part of the body that a bird, insect, or bat uses for flying	φτερούγα
16	sparkle	to shine brightly with a lot of small points of light	λάμπω, αστράφτω
17	ripple	a small wave on the surface of water →	κυματάκι, κυματισμός
18	gentle	calm, kind, or soft	ήπιος, ήρεμος, ευγενικός
19	chum the water	"Chumming" is a fishing method used only with a boat where you dump fish food, bait etc over the side of the boat, usually to attract fish	
20	dodge	avoid	αποφεύγω, κάνω ελιγμό
21	shore	section of land bordering water	ακτή
22	webbed feet	If a bird or animal has webbed feet, its toes are connected by skin to help it when swimming	πόδια με μεμβράνη
23	beak →	the hard, pointed part of a bird's mouth	ράμφος
24	strain	make strenuous physical effort	ζορίζομαι, κοπιάζω
25	feather →	one of the many soft, light things that cover a bird's body, consisting of a long, thin, central part with material like hairs along each side	φτερό
26	ruffle feathers		σηκώνω φτερά
27	stall	to delay or put off action	καθυστερώ
28	falter	to lose strength or purpose and stop, or almost stop	χάνω τη δύναμή μου, δεν αντέχω άλλο
29	disgrace	embarrassment and the loss of other people's respect, or behaviour that causes this	ντροπή, εξευτελισμός
30	dishonour	a feeling of embarrassment and loss of people's respect, or a situation in which you experience this	ατίμωση, ντροπή
31	stretch	lengthen, extend	τεντώνω
32	tremble	to shake slightly in a way that you cannot control, for example because you are frightened, angry, or excited, or because of illness	τρέμω
33	curve	line or form that bends	καμπύλη, στροφή

35	dismay	to make someone feel unhappy and disappointed	απογοητεύω
36	glide	the action of floating on air currents, rather than using power from wings or an engine	ρευστή κίνηση (σα να γλιστράς)
37	daring	brave and taking risks	τολμηρός

39	chicken-hearted	fearful, cowardly	δειλός
40	decisive	making firm decisions	αποφασιστικός
41	cowardly	(of a person) not at all brave and too eager to avoid danger, difficulty, or pain	δειλός, ανάνδρος
42	arrogant	unpleasantly proud and behaving as if you are more important than, or know more than, other people	υπερόπτης, αλαζόνας
43	risky	involving the possibility of something bad happening	ριψοκίνδυνος
44	single-minded	very determined to achieve something	αποφασισμένος, ανυποχώρητος
45	dynamic	having a lot of ideas and enthusiasm	δυναμικός
46	persistent	Someone who is persistent continues doing something or tries to do something in a determined but often unreasonable way	επίμονος
47	flexible	able to change or be changed easily according to the situation	ευπροσάρμοστος
48	headstrong	very determined to do what you want without listening to others	ισχυρογνώμων, πεισματάρης
49	submissive	allowing yourself to be controlled by other people or animals	υποτακτικός, υποτελής
50	revolutionary	bringing or causing great change	επαναστατικός, καινοτόμος
51	resourceful	skilled at solving problems and making decisions on your own	επινοητικός, εφευρετικός
52	non-conformist	someone who lives and thinks in a way that is different from other people	αντικομορφμιστής
53	non-conformity	the quality of living and thinking in a way that is different from other people	αντικομορφμισμός, μη συμμόρφωση
54	book blurb	a short description of a book, film, etc., written by the people who have produced it, and intended to make people want to buy it or see it	περιγραφή, περίληψη βιβλίου
55	inspire	to make someone feel that they want to do something and can do it	εμπνέω
56	convention	a usual or accepted way of behaving, especially in social situations, often following an old way of thinking or a custom in one particular society	κανόνας, σύμβαση
57	fable	a short story that tells a general truth or is only partly based on fact, or literature of this type	μύθος, θρύλος
58	norm	an accepted standard or a way of behaving or doing things that most people agree with	κανόνας, νόρμα
59	flock	group of birds	σμήνος
60	tribe	a group of people, often of related families, who live in the same area and share the same language, culture, and history	φυλή
61	soar	to rise very quickly to a high level	ανέρχομαι, ανυψώνομαι
