| 1 | addiction addictive | an inability to stop doing or using something, especially something harmful causing dependence εθισμός εθιστικός |
| 2 | catchy | (especially of a tune or song) pleasing and easy to remember πιασάρικος |
| 3 | psychoactive drug | a drug that affects your mind / a mind-altering substance ψυχοτρόπο φάρμακο |
| 4 | insomnia | the condition of being unable to sleep, over a period of time αϋπνία |
| 5 | indigestion | pain that you get in your stomach when you have eaten food that is difficult to digest δυσπεψία |
| 6 | lethargic | having little energy; feeling unwilling and unable to do anything ληθαργικός |
| 7 | withdrawal symptoms | the unpleasant physical and mental effects that result when you stop doing or taking something, especially a drug, that has become a habit συμπτώματα στέρησης |
| 8 | prohibit | to officially refuse to allow something απαγορεύω |
| 9 | sale | an act of exchanging something for money πώληση |
| 10 | entry | the act of entering a place or joining a particular society or organization είσοδος, δικαίωμα εισόδου |
| 11 | law | a rule, usually made by a government, that is used to order the way in which a society behaves νόμος |
| 12 | enforce | to make people obey a law, or to make a particular situation happen or be accepted εφαρμόζω, επιβάλλω (π.χ. νόμο) |
| 13 | potentially | possibly πιθανώς, ενδεχομένως, δυνητικά |
| 14 | lethal | able to cause or causing death; extremely dangerous θανατηφόρος, θανάσιμος, φονικός |
| 15 | adulterated | Adulterated foods or drugs have been made weaker or worse in quality, especially by having something added to the them νοθευμένος |
| 16 | spirit | a strong alcoholic drink αλκοολούχο, οινοπνευματώδες ποτό |
| 17 | consumption | the act of using, eating, or drinking something κατανάλωση |
| 18 | widespread | existing or happening in many places and/or among many people ευρέως διαδεδομένος, εκτεταμένος |
| 19 | respondent | a person who answers a request for information ερωτηθείς |
| 20 | morbidity | the morbidity of a disease is how many people have it in a particular population νοσηρότητα |
| 21 | mortality | the number of deaths within a particular society and within a particular period of time θνησιμότητα |
| 22 | legal | allowed by the law νόμιμος |
| 23 | multidimensional | having many different features πολυδιάστατος |
| 24 | approach | a way of considering or doing something προσέγγιση |
| 25 | issue | a subject or problem that people are thinking and talking about ζήτημα, θέμα |
| 26 | under no circumstances | not for any reason σε καμία περίπτωση |
| 27 | innocent | (of a thing) not intended to harm anyone (of a person) not guilty of a particular crime αθώος |
| 28 | clinical psychologist | sb who treats psychological disorders κλινικός ψυχολόγος |
| 29 | heritage | features belonging to the culture of a particular society, such as traditions, languages, or buildings, that were created in the past and still have historical importance κληρονομιά |
| 30 | festive | having or producing happy and enjoyable feelings suitable for a festival or other special occasion εορταστικός |
| 31 | hold onto sb/sth | to hold something or someone firmly with your hands or your arms κρατιέμαι από κάτι, δε χάνω, διατηρώ |
| 32 | trait | a particular characteristic that can produce a particular type of behaviour χαρακτηριστικό, γνώρισμα, στοιχείο |

| 33 | harmful harmless | causing harm not able or not likely to cause harm | βλαβερός, επιβλαβής, επιζήμιος αβλαβής, που δεν κάνει κακό |
| 34 | consequence | a result of a particular action or situation, often one that is bad or not convenient | συνέπεια |
| 35 | misguided | unreasonable or unsuitable because of being based on bad judgment or on wrong information or beliefs | λανθασμένος, εσφαλμένος |
| 36 | practice | something that is usually or regularly done, often as a habit, tradition, or custom | συνήθεια, τακτική |
| 37 | spur (v) | to encourage an activity or development or make it happen faster | ενθαρρύνω, ωθώ |
| 38 | mystique | a quality of being special in a mysterious and attractive way | αύρα/πέπλο μυστηρίου, αίγλη, γοητεία |
| 39 | breed (v) | to cause something to happen, usually something bad | δημιουργώ, προκαλώ |
| 40 | familiarity | a good knowledge of something, or the fact that you know it so well | οικειότητα |
| 41 | rural | in, of, or like the countryside | αγροτικός, εξοχικός |
| 42 | minor | someone who is too young to have the legal responsibilities of an adult | ανήλικος |
| 43 | decrease | to become less, or to make something become less | μειώνομαι, ελαττώνομαι |
| 44 | steadily | gradually, continuously | σταθερά |
| 45 | awareness | knowledge that something exists, or understanding of a situation or subject at the present time based on information or experience | επίγνωση, αντίληψη, συναίσθηση, γνώση |
| 46 | acknowledge | to accept, admit, or recognize something, or the truth or existence of something | αναγνωρίζω, παραδέχομαι |
| 47 | ban | to forbid (= refuse to allow) sth, especially officially | απαγορεύω |
| 48 | challenge | (the situation of being faced with) something that needs great mental or physical effort in order to be done successfully and therefore tests a person's ability | πρόκληση |
| 49 | proliferation | the fact of something increasing a lot and suddenly in number or amount | πολλαπλασιασμός, γρήγορη εξάπλωση |
| 50 | fizzy drink | carbonated beverage | αναψυκτικό |
| 51 | alarming | causing worry or fear | ανησυχητικός |
| 52 | drastic measures | (especially of actions) severe and sudden or having very noticeable effects | δραστικά μέτρα |
| 53 | mistaken | incorrect | λανθασμένος |
| 54 | attitude | a feeling or opinion about something or someone, or a way of behaving that is caused by this | στάση, συμπεριφορά |
| 55 | detrimental | causing harm or damage | επιβλαβής, επιζήμιος, βλαβερός |
| 56 | country-specific | used to describe a product or service that is designed for a particular country, rather than for many countries | (ανά χώρα) που αναφέρεται σε μία χώρα |
| 57 | common practice | often done | κοινή πρακτική |
| 58 | complicated | involving a lot of different parts, in a way that is difficult to understand | πολύπλοκος, μπλεγμένος |
| 59 | tolerant | willing to accept behaviour and beliefs that are different from your own, although you might not agree with or approve of them | ανεκτικός |
