Scenario 1 – At the school playground

Student A: you want to go to the cinema with your friends. You love action films and you know that there's a good one on. Try to convince them to watch this film. Remember to mention: plot, characters, director, prizes etc. (reach an agreement)

Student B: your friend invites you to watch an action film at the cinema but you don't like action films. You prefer comedies. Try to convince him/her watch the movie you prefer. (Reach an agreement)

Student C: your friend invites you to watch an action film at the cinema. You like action films but you prefer to watch a new release that is actually an animation. Try to convince him/her watch the movie you prefer. (Reach an agreement)

Student D: your friend invites you to watch an action film at the cinema. You like action films but you are always watching action films so you prefer to watch something different this time. Try to convince him/her. (Reach an agreement)

Scenario 2 - At the box office

Student A: you booked two tickets online. When you arrive at the cinema with your friend you realize that the ticket machine in out of order. You get angry and you ask the clerk for help.

Student B: your friend booked two tickets online but he can't get them from the machine. He/she gets really angry and you try to explain that there must be an alternative solution.

Student C: you work at the box office of a cinema. A customer bought 2 tickets online but he can't get them from the machine because it's out of order. Try to find a solution.

Scenario 3 - In the cinema shop

Student A: you work at the cinema shop and you sell popcorn and soft drinks to customers. Serve a customer.

Student B: you go to the cinema to watch a film. During the break, you go to the cinema shop to buy some popcorn.

Scenario 4 - Outside the cinema

A group of friends have just watched a really good film. They discuss about it after the film finishes.

Student A: you comment on the plot of the movie

Student B: you comment on the actors

Student C: you comment on the music and the director

Student D: you comment on the plot Student E: you comment on the plot
