Dear Friends,

The Moraitis School Forensics Club is pleased to invite your school to the seventeenth annual Moraitis School Cup, at Moraitis School on **Friday February 6th and Saturday February 7th, 2026**. The theme for this year's F1-inspired Moraitis Cup is "Debate to Survive"!

As usual, this year's Moraitis Cup will include a juniors' tournament for debaters born in 2014 and an impromptu competition for seniors. For the seniors' debating competition (for junior and senior high school students), schools may send **up to eight (8) teams**. Also, the 'n- 2' rule will apply, meaning that for n number of teams, your institution must have n minus 2 (or more) judges available for each of the four preliminary rounds. For the impromptu competition, schools may send **up to five (5) speakers** and an 'n-1' rule for the judges applies in this case. You are welcome to register additional teams or impromptu speakers on the same form, and you will be notified in case a spot opens up.

Attached you will find the registration links for the forms you will need to complete and the schedule of events.

Please register your junior and senior teams, judges and impromptu speakers by filling in the forms and paying the registration fees by **January 23, 2026**. Failure to register on time will result in an increased registration fee.

Registration

Eligibility and Adjudication

The tournament is open to primary school students born in 2014, junior and senior high school students.

For the debate competition, there is a cap of 8 guaranteed teams, with the option of submitting additional waiting list teams.

For the impromptu competition, there is a cap of 5 guaranteed speakers, with the option of submitting additional waiting list speakers.

Each institution must have **n-2 debate** judges available and **n-1 impromptu** judges for every preliminary round.
