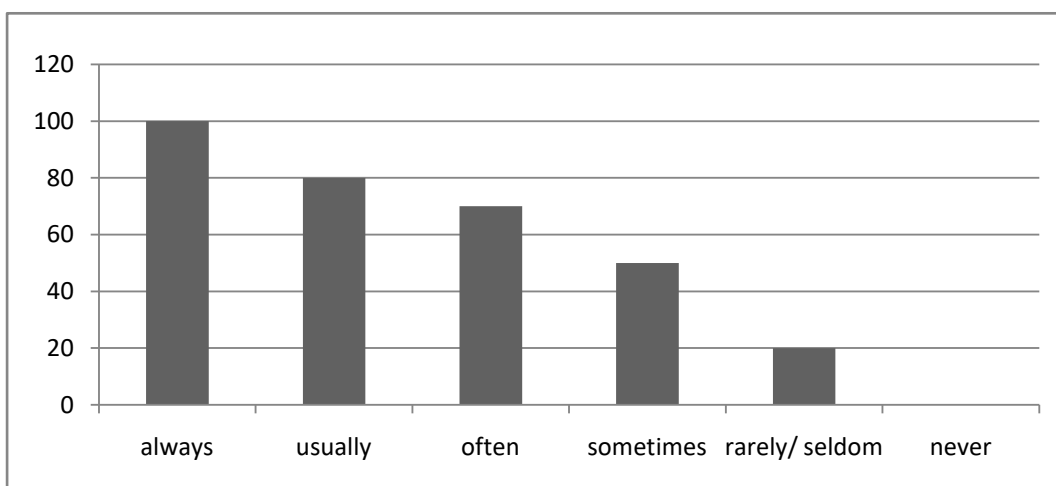




Adverbs of frequency = Επιρρήματα συχνότητας

Τα επιρρήματα συχνότητας δείχνουν **πόσο συχνά** γίνεται η πράξη που δηλώνει το ρήμα της πρότασης. Απαντούν στην ερώτηση **“How often?”** = **«Πόσο συχνά;»** και συντάσσονται με **Simple Present**. Αυτά είναι:

always=πάντα
usually=συνήθως
often=συχνά
sometimes=μερικές φορές
rarely/ seldom= σπάνια
never= ποτέ



Τα επιρρήματα συχνότητας μπαίνουν **πριν το κύριο ρήμα**

e.g. He usually tells the truth.

They sometimes visit us at the weekend.

αλλά:

Μετά το βοηθητικό ρήμα (π.χ. do/ does/ don't/ doesn't) και **μετά το ρήμα to be**.

e.g. She doesn't often do her homework.

Andy is never rude. He is always kind.
