

1 "Explain this like I'm five, like I'm a college student, and like I'm an expert."

Pick any topic (e.g., quantum computing, the stock market, sourdough baking) and ask:

"Explain quantum computing like I'm five, like I'm in college, and like I'm an expert."

- **Why it's powerful:** Shows how ChatGPT can instantly tailor complexity and tone for different audiences.

2 "Plan a [goal] for me step-by-step and give me a first action I can take today."

Example: "Plan a 4-week beginner strength routine I can do at home with only dumbbells. Include a shopping list and today's first workout."

- **Why it's powerful:** Demonstrates actionable planning, personalization, and immediate next steps.

3 "Turn this messy info into a clear, usable format."

Paste a long email chain, notes, or a wall of text and ask:

"Summarize these notes into 3 key decisions, 5 action items, and a one-sentence TL;DR."

- **Why it's powerful:** Shows instant organization of chaos into something you can act on.

4 "Generate 10 creative ideas with unexpected twists."

Example: "Give me 10 Instagram video ideas to promote a small coffee shop, each with a surprising hook or trend to ride."

- **Why it's powerful:** Reveals creative brainstorming and trend-aware suggestions you can immediately use.

5 “Be my [role] and help me practice.”

Example: “Pretend you’re a hiring manager. Give me 5 tough interview questions for a product manager role and critique my answers.”

- **Why it’s powerful:** Shows interactive role-play—coaching, feedback, and simulation all in one.

 **Pro tip:** After each answer, say “*Can you push this further?*” or “*Give me 3 wild alternatives.*” Seeing the iteration is where people really feel the power.
