The words in bold are **relative pronouns**. Relative pronouns replace nouns and also link sentences. They have the same form for singular and plural:

The girl who is raising her hand is an excellent pupil.

The girls who are raising their hands are excellent pupils.

- who, whom and whose are only used with persons
- which is only used with things or animals
- that is used for things and persons
- sometimes we can omit the relative pronoun, when it is not the subject of the verb:

 - e.g. The museum that I visited ... / The museum I visited
