

Present Simple

Mary wants to be here with me. You are a very nice person.






Present Perfect

have/has + past participle


Has she ever ridden the horse? I have finished my homework. She has not been to London.



Present Continuous

to be (am/is/are) + ing form

He is not studying very well. I am washing all the dishes.



Present Perfect Continuous

have/has + been + ing form

I have not been doing my homework for 6 hours I have been doing my homework for 6 hours. Have I been doing my homework for 6 hours?
