

## Present Simple

verb + (-s / -es)

*I like it.*

*You are a very nice person.*

*Mary wants to be here with me.*

X X X X X X X X X X



## Present Continuous

to be (am/is/are) + ing form

*I am washing all the dishes.*

*He is not studying very well.*

*Are you listening to the music?*

[Red bar]



## Present Perfect

have/has + past participle

*I have finished my homework.*

*She has not been to London.*

*Has she ever ridden the horse?*

X X



## Present Perfect Continuous

have/has + been + ing form

*I have been doing my homework for 6 hours.*

*I have not been doing my homework for 6 hours.*

*Have I been doing my homework for 6 hours?*

[Red arrow]



## Past Simple

verb + ed (or irregular)

*I finished my work and **went** to the beach.*  
*I **lived** in London for 3 years.*  
*I **was** at home today.*

**X**



## Past Perfect

had + past participle

*I **had** never seen something like that.*  
*I **had** broken up with her.*  
*She **hadn't** had time to explain it.*

**X**



## Past Continuous

was / were + ing form

*I **was** doing my homework.*  
*I **was** not doing my homework.*  
***Was** I doing my homework?*

**X**



## Past Perfect Continuous

had + been + ing form

*I **had** been doing my homework.*  
*I **had** not been doing my homework.*  
***Had** I been doing my homework?*
