

QUANTIFIERS WITH COUNTABLE AND UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

LOOK AT THE EXAMPLES :

- There is **a banana** in the fridge
- There are **some bananas** in the fridge **affirmative**
- There is **some milk** in the fridge
- There are **a lot of bananas** in the fridge
- There is **a lot of milk** in the fridge
- There are **(a) few bananas** in the fridge
- There is **(a) little milk** in the fridge

- There isn't **a banana** in the fridge
- There aren't **any bananas** in the fridge
- There isn't **any milk** in the fridge **negative**
- There aren't **many bananas** in the fridge
- There isn't **much milk** in the fridge

- Is there **a banana** in the fridge?
- Are there **any bananas** in the fridge?
- Is there **any milk** in the fridge? **question**
- **How many bananas** are there in the fridge?
- **How much milk** is there in the fridge?

SOME / ANY / A LOT OF → **C & U** nouns

MANY / (A) FEW / HOW MANY → **C** nouns

MUCH / (A) LITTLE / HOW MUCH → **U** nouns

A LOT OF / MANY / MUCH → ΜΕΓΑΛΗ ΠΟΣΟΤΗΤΑ

A FEW / A LITTLE → ΛΙΓΑ ΆΛΛΑ ΑΡΚΕΤΑ

FEW / LITTLE → ΠΟΛΥ ΛΙΓΑ
