Affirmative

- I read
- You read
- He reads
- She reads
- It reads
- We read
- You read
- They read

<u>Interrogative</u>

- Do I read?
- Do you read?
- Does he read?
- Does she read?
- Does it read?
- Do we read?
- Do you read?
- Do they read?

Negative

- I do not read / I don't read
- You do not read / You don't read
- He does not read / He doesn't read
- She does not read / She doesn't read
- It does not read / It doesn't read
- We do not read / We don't read
- You do not read / You don't read
- They do not read / They don't read

Short answers

Do you get up early?
 Yes, I do. / No, I don't.

Does he clean up his room?
 Yes, he does. / No, he doesn't.

Do they watch TV?
 Yes, they do. / No, they don't.

Spelling Rules

Ο γενικός κανόνας είναι ότι στο γ' ενικό (he, she, it) στην κατάφαση προσθέτουμε ένα -s. e.g. He swims.

Υπάρχουν όμως κι εξαιρέσεις:

1) Όσα ρήματα λήγουν σε sh, ch, ss, x, o, παίρνουν -es. e.g. she brushes/watches/dresses/fixes/goes

2) Όσα ρήματα λήγουν σε **σύμφωνο + y** παίρνουν -ies. e.g. he cries/she tries/it flies (αλλά λέμε he plays, γιατί πριν το **y** υπάρχει **φωνήεν**)

<u>Use</u>

O Present Simple εκφράζει:

- Συνήθεια, επαναλαμβανόμενη πράξη, ρουτίνα.
- e.g. I always go to school on foot.

 My mum makes us breakfast every morning.
- Μόνιμη κατάσταση.
- e.g. My dad <u>works</u> in a bank. I <u>live</u> in a small town.
- Γενική αλήθεια, νόμο της φύσης.
- e.g. In the summer it gets very hot.

 The sun <u>rises</u> in the east.
