Affirmative

I was flying

You were flying

He was flying

She was flying

It was flying

We were flying

You were flying

They were flying

<u>Interrogative</u>

Was I sleeping?

Were you sleeping?

Was he sleeping?

Was she sleeping?

Was it sleeping?

Were we sleeping?

Were you sleeping?

Were they sleeping?

Negative

I was not / wasn't reading You were not / weren't reading He was not / wasn't reading She was not / wasn't reading It was not / wasn't reading We were not / weren't reading You were not / weren't reading They were not / weren't reading

Short answers

Were you studying?

Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't.

Were they talking?

Yes, they were. / No, they weren't.

SPELLING RULES

Σε ορισμένα ρήματα συμβαίνουν αλλαγές στην ορθογραφία τους όταν παίρνουν την κατάληξη - **ing**:

- 1. Όταν το ρήμα λήγει σε -e, αυτό φεύγει και μπαίνει στη θέση του το -ing.
- e.g. make + ing = making give + ing = giving
- 2. Όταν το ρήμα τελειώνει σε **σύμφωνο τονισμένο φωνήεν σύμφωνο**, διπλασιάζει το τελευταίο του σύμφωνο.
- **e.g.** hit + ing = hitting begin + ing = beginning
- 3. Όταν το ρήμα λήγει σε -Ι, αυτό διπλασιάζεται (στα Βρετανικά Αγγλικά).
- **e.g.** travel + ing = travelling
- 4. Όταν το ρήμα λήγει σε -ie, τότε αυτό φεύγει και μπαίνει στη θέση του το -ying.
- e.g. lie + ing = lying tie + ing = tying die + ing = dying

<u>Use</u>

Ας δούμε τι εκφράζει ο Past Continuous:

1. Yesterday at 6 p.m. I was watching a film on TV.

My mum was cooking all morning.

2. While George was studying, his sister was talking on the phone.

Δύο ή περισσότερες πράξεις που συνέβαιναν παράλληλα στο παρελθόν.

3. I was walking on the beach when it started to rain.

Μια πράξη που εξελισσόταν όταν τη διέκοψε μια άλλη πιο σύντομη πράξη (η οποία είναι σε Past Simple)
