


Nouns eding in -s, -ss, -sh, -ch, -x, -o take -es in the plural.




★ But some nouns ending in -o take only -s. radio-radios; photo-photos; rhino-rhinos



Nouns ending in a **vowel + y** take **-s** in the plural



Nouns ending in a **consonant + y**, **drop the y** and tahes **–ies** in the plural.




★ Nouns ending in -f or -fe, drop the -f or -fe and take -ves in the plural
