He + verb + -s

Affirmative

I / you work

He/She/It works

We/You/They work

Interrogative

Do I/You work?

Does he/she/it
work?

Do we/you/they
work?

Negative

I/You don't work

He/She/It
doesn't work

We/You/They
don't work

verbs in -ss, -sh, -ch, -x, -o, -z

→ + -es

• e.g. watch - he watches

verbs in consonant + -y

→ + -ies

• e.g. fly - he flies
