

CLAUSES OF RESULT

So...that=τόσο ... που

Such (a)..... that= τέτοιος... που, τόσο ...που

SO

so + adjective/adverb

eg He was so tired that he went to bed early.
He drove so dangerously that he nearly killed the cyclist.

so +adjective+a/an +singular countable noun

eg.It was so great a trip that I'll never forget it.(=It was such a great trip that I'll never forget it.)

so+ much, many, few, little + NOUN

eg There was so much traffic that I was late for work.
I have so many things to do and so little time!

SUCH

such a(n) +(adjective) countable noun
such +(adj) uncountable or plural noun

eg It was such a boring (adjective) story (noun) that nobody liked it.
He was such a liar that nobody believed him.
It was such terrible weather (uncountable noun) that we stayed in.
They are such interesting books (plural noun) that we want to buy them all.

such a lot of + noun

Mother had baked such a lot of cookies that we couldn't eat them all.
