CLAUSES OF RESULT

So...that=τόσο ... που

Such (a)..... that= τέτοιος... που, τόσο ...που

SO

so + adjective/adverb

eg He was so tired that he went to bed early.

He drove so dangerously that he nearly killed the cyclist.

so +adjective+a/an +singular countable noun

eg.It was so great a trip that I'll never forget it.(=It was such a great trip that I'll never forget it.)

so+ much, many, few, little + NOUN

eg There was so much traffic that I was late for work. I have so many things to do and so little time!

SUCH

such a(n) +(adjective) countable noun such +(adj) uncountable or plural noun

eg It was such a boring (<u>adjective</u>) story (<u>noun</u>) that nobody liked it.

He was such a liar that nobody believed him.

It was such terrible weather (<u>uncountable noun</u>) that we stayed in.

They are such interesting books (plural noun) that we want to buy them all.

such a lot of + noun

Mother had baked such a lot f cookies that we couldn't eat them all.
