

Simple Present with Future Meaning

The Simple Present is used in clauses of time and condition to refer to the future
eg when I see him, I'll phone you
I'll wait until I see him

The Present Perfect can also be used with when etc
eg I'll speak to you when I've finished

when

As soon as

Before

After

If/Unless

Until

the minute that

the moment that

in case

now that,

Present Simple

I see him,

Future Simple

I'll phone you

Going to or the imperative can be used, when necessary) instead of the Future Simple

eg I've decided what to do. I am going to talk to him when he gets there.

Phone me when he arrives
