"Lithium" is a song by American rock band Nirvana, written by frontman Kurt Cobain.. It appears as the fifth track and third single from their second album Nevermind (1991). Cobain said the song is about a man who, after the death of his girlfriend, turns to religion to avoid becoming suicidal, which suggests a connection with lithium's use to control bipolar disorder.

Nirvana was an American rock band formed in Aberdeen, Washington in 1987. It was by lead singer-songwriter and guitarist Kurt Cobain and bassist Krist Novoselic.

In the late 1980s, Nirvana established itself as part of the Seattle grunge, releasing its first album, Bleach in 1989. Nirvana unexpected mainstream success with "Smells Like Teen Spirit", the first single from their landmark second album Nevermind (1991), a phenomenon of the 1990s. Their music maintains a popular and continues to influence modern rock and roll culture.

Characterized by their punk aesthetic, Nirvana's of pop melodies with noise, combined with their themes of abjection and social alienation, brought them popularity. The band released their third studio album, In Utero in 1993. Nirvana disbanded following Cobain's in April 1994.

By 2009, Nirvana record sales were over 75 million, making them one of the best-selling bands of all time. During their three years as a mainstream act, Nirvana received an American Music Award, Brit Award and Grammy Award, as well as seven MTV Video Music Awards and two NME Awards. They five number-one hits on the Billboard Songs chart and four number-one albums on the Billboard 200. In 2004, Rolling Stone named Nirvana among the 100 greatest artists of all time. They were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2014.
