* Leonardo Da Vinci *

	born of parents not married to each other
	to work for a skilled person for a particular period of time and often for low payment, in order to learn that person's skills
	being in control and making all the decisions
	to become worse
	very interesting because of being unusual or mysterious
	a person of high social rank, esp. from birth
	without any success or any effect
	short or quick
	writing, especially when well-formed
	composed of elements drawn from various sources
	a device for slowing the descent of a person or object through the air that consists of a fabric canopy beneath which the person or object is suspended
	using ideas and methods that have never been used before
	certainly
	a result of two or more things joining together
	the thick main stem of a tree, from which its branches grow
	surprising and sometimes worrying
	to state or declare positively and often forcefully

* Michelangelo *

	a judge in a law court who deals with crimes that are not serious
	a person or group that gives money or support to a person, an activity, or an organization
	to force someone to leave a country, organization, or school
	to choose someone to do a piece of work, or to have a piece of work done
	a structure or underground room where someone, esp. an important person, is buried
	a table or place which serves as a center of worship or ritual —often used with <i>the</i> to refer to the act of getting married
	a serious and often continuing competition
	the way that something is represented or shown
	to strip off the skin or surface of

* Sandro Botticelli *

	A person who changes animal skin into leather using special chemicals
	someone who makes objects from gold
	to try to deal with something or someone
	Showing little skill
	Held in great respect, admired

* Raphael *

	able to do something well
	the important people who live in the official home of a queen or king or who work for or advise them
	having or showing a special advantage
	disagreement or debate (= formal discussion of a topic on which people disagree)
	the holy bread and wine eaten at Holy Communion (= a religious ceremony)
	(of something bad) happening unexpectedly early or at a time which is not suitable

* Andrea del Verrocchio *

	connected with the riding of horses
	connected with the act of religious worship
	to do or be better than
