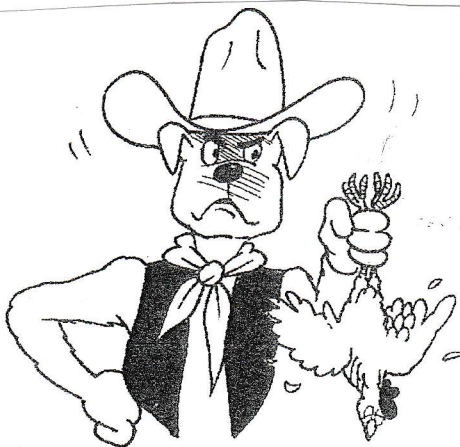


(A) Make appropriate questions :
