FIRST CONDITIONAL	USE	EXAMPLES	
If ⊕ + Present Simple , ⊕ + Future Simple If ⊕ + Present Simple , ⊕ + can / may + infinitive		If he tries hard enough, he will / can / may pass the exam.

NOTES

* REMEMBER:




