Affirmative: I, you, he/she/it, we, you, they will be playing Interrogative: will I, you, he/she/it, we, you, they be playing? Negative: I, you, he/she/it, we, you, they will not be playing

SHORT FORMS

Affirmative Negative I'll, you'll I won't, he'll, she'll ... you won't ...

YES / NO ANSWERS:

- Yes, I/you... will.
- No, I/you... won't.


