### Simple Past – Examples and rules – English tenses

#### Simple Past

Examples: Simple Past

First I **read** a book, then I **went** to bed yesterday evening. Last week I **came** to a church and then I **took** the road right.

Simple Past describes an action started and finished at a specific time in the past.

Examples:

Bob got a bike yesterday. Mr Thompson had a great time in America last year.

### Simple Past – regular verbs

Regular verbs make their past tense by adding -d, -ed, or (if the verb ends in a consonant + y), changing the y to i and adding -ed.

Special notes:

Verb ending	add	Examples
-е	Add - <b>d</b>	live - live <b>d</b> bake - bake <b>d</b>
<u>consonant</u> + y	Change 'y' to <b>i</b> and add - <b>ed</b>	carry - carr <b>ied</b> cry - cr <b>ied</b>
1 <u>vowel</u> + 1 c <u>onsonant</u>	Double <u>consonant</u> and add - <b>ed</b>	sto <mark>p</mark> - sto <mark>pp</mark> ed

#### Simple Past - irregular verbs

Examples: Simple Past tense irregular verbs:

Present - Past	Present - Past
begin - <mark>began</mark>	fall - <mark>fell</mark>
break - broke	forget - forgot
come - came	get - got
drink - drank	speak - spoke

## Simple Past - Signal Words

Signal words: ago, in 2011 ..., in 1999 ..., last month, last week, last year, yesterday, at 5 o'clock

Examples Simple Past signal words

I **ate** oranges last year. We **went** to school eyery day in 1999. He **took** his dog for a walk a month ago.

## Simple Past - questions

### 'did' + usubject + infinitive

Examples: Simple Past questions

I **ate** apple in 2005. **Did I eat** apples in 2005? We **went** to London last week. **Did we go** to London last week? He **took** his dog for a walk last week. **Did he take** his dog for a walk last week?

### Simple Past - questions with was/were

Examples:

She **was** in London. **Was** she in London? They **were** at the station. **Were** they at the station?

### Simple Past negative

Long form: I **did not go**. Short form: I **didn't go**.

Examples:

I knew Covent Garden? I did't know Covent Garden. We went to school eyery day. We didn't go to school every day. He took his dog for a walk. He didn't take his dog for a walk.
